The inability of scientists to find data corroborating citizens claims stems partly from the pre-environmentalist assumptions still influencing the environmental health sciences, Tesh says. On the other hand, the conviction of activists that industrial pollutants threaten their health results from the environmental movement s success in promoting new ideas about nature. Tesh points to ways that environmentalist ideas have begun to affect science, thus making more likely the discovery of links between exposure to industrial pollutants and a community s health problems. Those ways include the expansion of diseases construed as environmental in cause, the study of society s most vulnerable citizens in determining safe levels of...
